

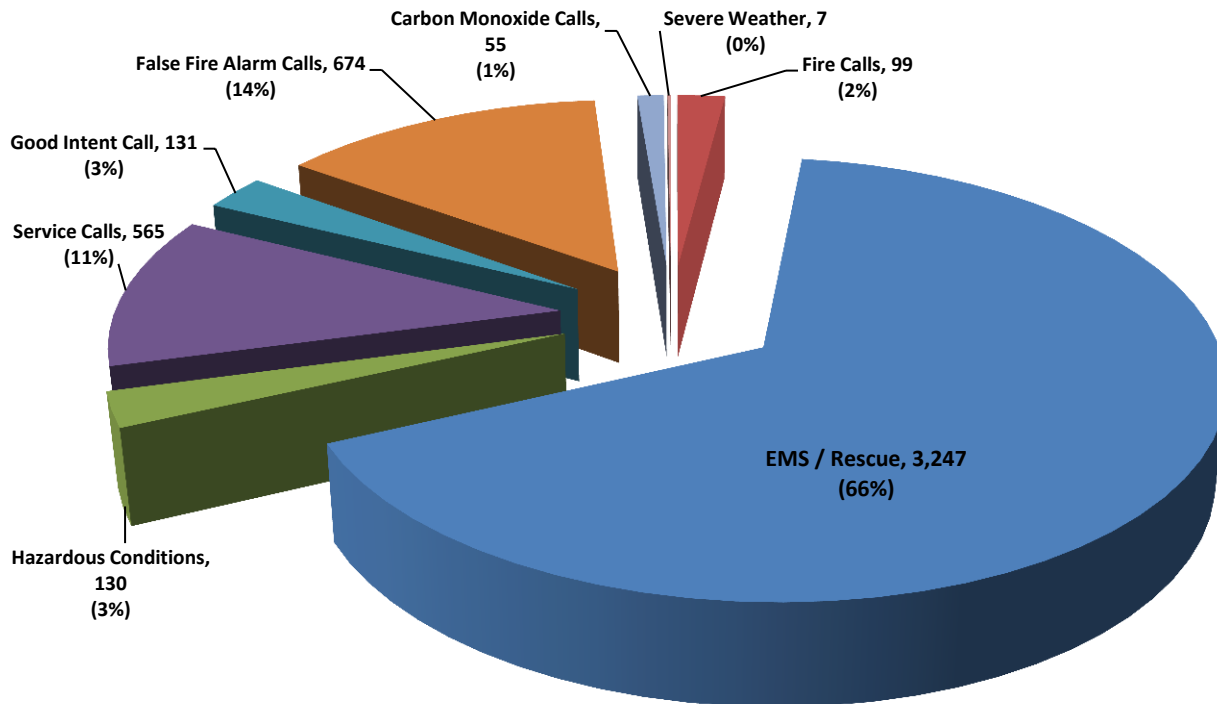

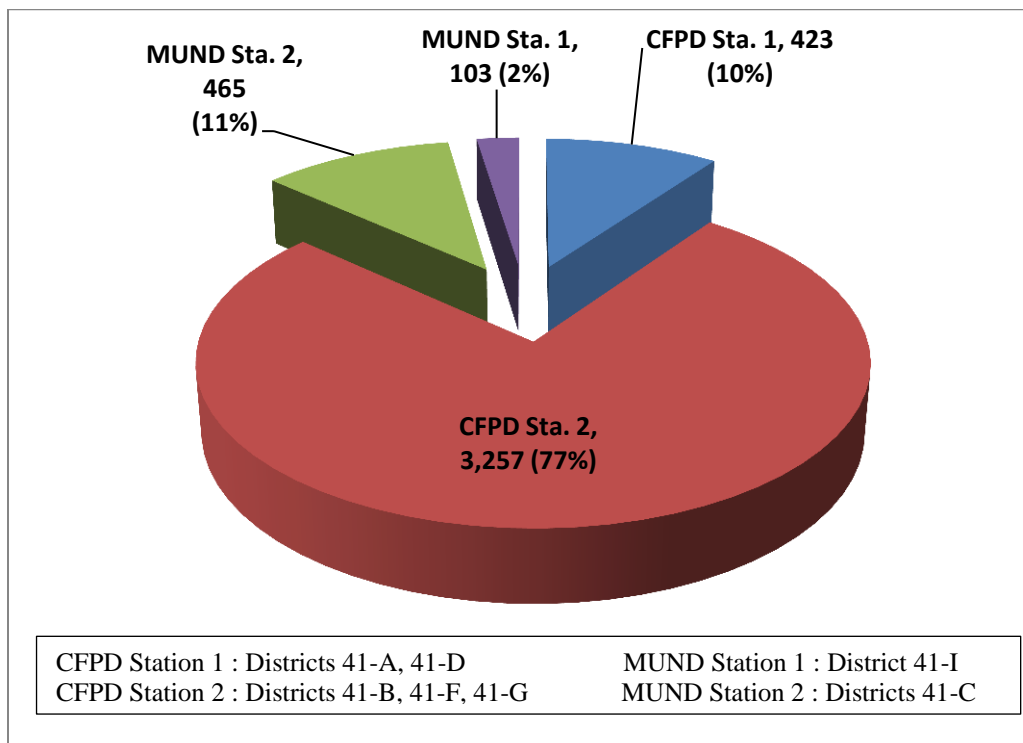

January – December 2016**



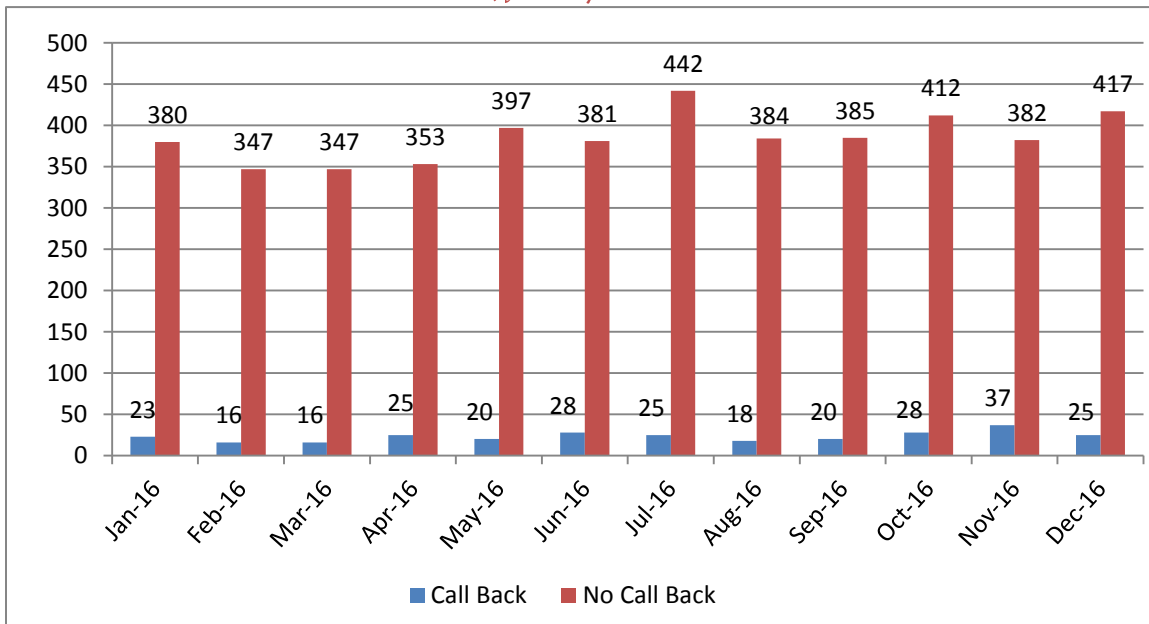
