- **Replace smoke alarms every ten years.**

Program Highlights:

- Provide and install **FREE** smoke alarms with 10-year lithium batteries.
- Provide and install **FREE** night lights.
- Provide **FREE** safety brochures on fire and fall prevention.
- Provide **FREE** home safety visits/ inspections for fire and fall hazards.
- Provide resources for additional help (public health, Dept. of Aging, etc.) if needed.



Who is the program for?

- Adults age 65 and older or under 65 with disabilities.
- Participants **MUST** live within the Countryside Fire Protection District.

How does the program work?

- Interested individuals may call our office to schedule an appointment for the **FREE** home safety visit.
- A minimum of two members of the community coalition will conduct the home visit.
- Home safety visits will incorporate safety inspections, safety education, and installation
